## INDIC KNOWLEDGE SYSTEM

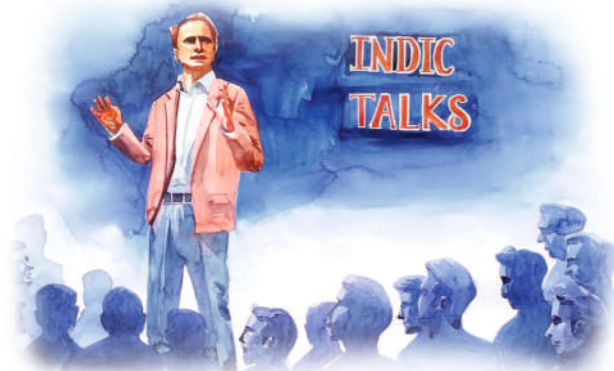

1) The CIS wants to initiate original research projects into frontier areas of sociology, anthropology, history and culture of India from indigenous perspective.

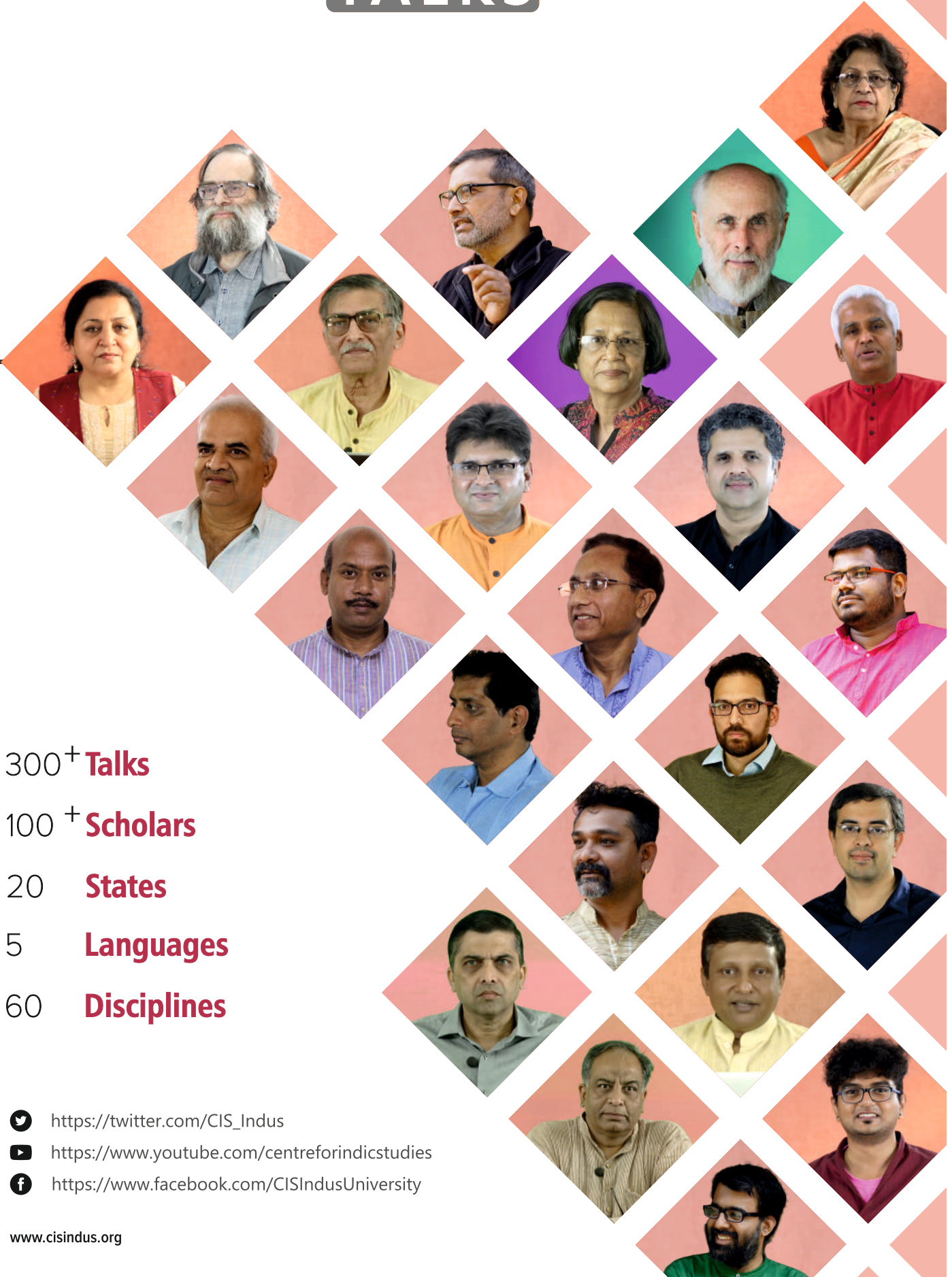
2) The CIS also wants to create an academic ecosystem for Mentor Mentee Relationship.
